Introduction

The University of Lincoln Bursary and Scholarship Schemes have been established to provide additional financial support, above that provided from Government, to encourage participation in Higher Education

University of Lincoln Scholarship

The University of Lincoln Scholarship of £500 is for students commencing their studies for the first time in 2016/17, 2017/18, 2018/19, 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24 or 2024/25, paying the tuition fee rate of £9,250 and in receipt of a full or partial Maintenance Loan.

Eligibility

- 1. Student commenced programme in Academic Year 2016/17, 2017/18, 2018/19, 2019/20, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23, 2023/24 or 2024/25.
- 2. Student is in receipt of a full or partial Maintenance Loan and has a household income of less than £45,875.
- 3. Student is on level 3, 4, 5, 6 or 7 of a full time undergraduate degree or foundation degree programme for the first time.
- 4. Student has up to date nominated bank details registered with Student Finance England/Student Loans Company.
- 5. Student is enrolled with the University of Lincoln at each eligibility point in the academic year detailed below.

Additional Details

The University of Lincoln Scholarship of £500 will be paid directly into the student's nominated bank account, in three instalments (£165, £165 and £170 respectively).

The University of Lincoln Scholarship will be paid for all levels of study for the first time that they are studied.

Exceptions

Students should be aware that any change of circumstance, personal or study-related, may lead to reassessment by SLC and subsequent change in eligibility of the University of Lincoln Support Package.

Students on Certificate of Higher Education programmes where there is no automatic progression route onto a degree programme are not eligible.

Students repeating a year of study are not eligible.

Lincoln Alumni Scholarship

Lincoln Blackburn Bursary

The University of Lincoln Blackburn Bursary targets those students coming to the University having previously received Local Authority care.

Eligibility

- 1. Students must be enrolled on the Student Information System on a full-time or part-time University of Lincoln Undergraduate programme for the current academic year.
- 2. Students must have a student status of Home on the Student Information System.
- 3. Students must have received Local Authority care and be a Care Leaver as defined by the Children Leaving Care Act 2000 within the five years prior to the start of the course.

Lincoln Foyer/Supported Housing Bursary

The Foyer/Supported Housing Bursary is for students who come directly from living in a Foyer or other supported housing, where they have lived between the ages of 16 to 18.
